<b>Definition</b>	Share of employed women of 15 years old and over in the total employed population, distributed by economic activities (7 sections according to the Classification of Activities in Moldova Economy (CAEM): agriculture, hunting and forestry, fishery; industry; constructions; wholesale and retail trade, hotels and restaurants; transport and communications; public administration, education, health and social work; other activities)

<b>Calculation formula</b>	$POND_{f\_act"x"} = N_{fo\_act"x"} / PO_{pto\_act"x"} * 100$ <p>where:</p> <p><math>POND_{f\_act"x"}</math>- share of women employed in economic activity „X”</p> <p><math>N_{fo\_act"x"}</math> – number of women employed in economic activity „X”</p> <p><math>PO_{pto\_act"x"}</math> - total population employed in economic activity „X”</p>
<b>Level of disaggregation</b>	<p>Data are available for the whole country (without the left part of the river Nistru and municipality Bender), as well as by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- statistical zones (North, Center, South and Chisinau mun.);</li> <li>- age groups;</li> <li>- sex;</li> <li>- area;</li> <li>- level of education;</li> <li>- marital status;</li> <li>- professional status.</li> </ul>
<b>Dissemination periodicity</b>	<p>Quarterly</p> <p>Annually</p>
<b>Timeliness</b>	<p>Quarterly – during one quarter after the reported quarter.</p> <p>Annually – April after the year of reference.</p>
<b>Revision</b>	Data are final at the first dissemination.

<b>Coherence with other statistics (correlated indicators)</b>	<p>Coherence of Labour Force Survey data with the data from statistical surveys in enterprises/economic and social units:</p> <p><u>Total employed population</u></p> <p><i>Differences in concepts:</i> statistical questionnaires in enterprises target only the population employed in enterprises.</p> <p><i>Differences in measurement:</i> statistical questionnaires in enterprises are carried out in enterprises/economic and social units. The collected information refers (as period of reference) to the calendar year (M3), or to the calendar month (M1).</p>
