Exports of commodities granted for free are assessed based on the FOB value for similar commodities.

Timeliness	On the 40 th day after the month/year of reference.
Revision	The data for the previous period are adjusted when identifying and correcting the data submitted previously by the Customs Service.
Data source	The detailed customs declaration serves as the main document for statistical records in case of the exports of material goods which are subject to trade transactions; this declaration is filled in at the Customs points when the goods exit the country. The statistical report No. EI-1 "Export (import) of electricity and natural gas" concluded by the exporter based on the delivery and receiving documents serves as a source of operative data for commodities transported through pipes or cable. The data from customs declarations are processed by the Customs Service of the Ministry of Finance and afterwards sent to the National Bureau of Statistics. NBS completes, finalizes, and disseminates the data regarding the external trade of commodities.
